

## Rates for 2011

All rates are daily.  
Check in time will be 3:00 pm and check out time will be 12:00 pm.  
The minimum charge for accommodations is \$1,500 per day.

### Weekend Rate

## Facility Rental Information

*Where Campers Come First*



Camp Easter Seal is a completely wheelchair accessible resort specially designed for children and adults with disabilities. Located near Watrous on the shores of Manitou Beach, our camp offers a beautiful environment of lake and wooded slopes. Camp Easter Seal is operated by the Saskatchewan Abilities Council and is open June through August. In September, the facility is available for rental.

Two main buildings at Camp provide a focal point for camping activities; a large dining hall with a well-equipped, modern kitchen and a chalet where a lounge is located. These beautiful buildings, nestled among the lush surrounding greenery, are finished in natural fieldstone and date back to the 1930's. From here, wheelchair accessible pathways wind through the grounds connecting 13 modern cabins.



### **Accommodations**

13 cabins are available. Cabins sleep up to 10 individuals and are equipped with air conditioning and washroom facilities. All cabins are heated. Guests must provide bedding.

Washroom facilities are located conveniently throughout the grounds.

The chalet is available as a gathering place. The main chalet area can hold up to 80 people comfortably and the small lounge can hold up to 60 comfortably. The chalet is available to all groups and included in the daily rate.

The dining hall can seat up to 130 people.

Tents, trailers and recreational vehicles will not be accommodated.

### **Programs**

A large indoor heated swimming pool is available. A lifeguard must supervise pool activities at all times and is the responsibility of the renters to obtain. Rental fees apply. Lake activities are at the discretion of the guests.

Many of the buildings can be used at the group's leisure. These program options are included in the daily rate.

A bonfire pit is also available.

Prior arrangements must be made to utilize any of the program areas.



### **Food Service Options**

The dining hall is available to all groups and included in the daily rate. The dining hall can seat 120 people for meals. The Dining Hall can seat 150 people (theatre style) for meetings.

#### **Option #1**

Kitchen facilities are available for groups.

Kitchen equipment and accessories are available. Rental fees apply.

#### **Option #2**

Groups may contract with a caterer or local restaurants.

Catering arrangements are the responsibility of the group.
